

Slightly more than 50% of consumers indicated they would build or purchase a single-family ranch home while 43% preferred a multi-level home.

TAKE AWAY: The two most popular types of homes were ranch and multi-level single family homes. Fewer than 10% of consumers surveyed would prefer a condo or townhome.

Purpose:

To understand what style of home consumers were looking for in their dream home.

Methodology:

AIM surveyed a random selection of homeowners of all different ages and incomes across the U.S. There were 373 respondents to the research.

Conclusion:

Geographic location can impact the style of home consumers prefer in their "dream home." While single-family ranch homes are most popular overall, homeowners in Mountain and Pacific states are more likely to prefer a ranch-style home: 70% of consumers in Mountain states and 60% in Pacific states prefer ranch homes. Consumers in Mid and South Atlantic states are more likely to purchase or build multi-level homes. Not surprisingly, 61% of older consumers (55+) are more likely to prefer ranch-style homes. Consumers with household incomes over \$200,000 tend prefer multi-level homes.
